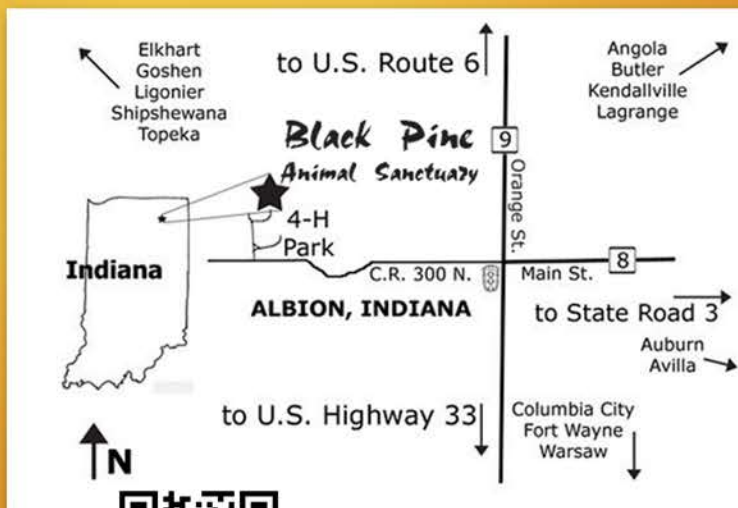

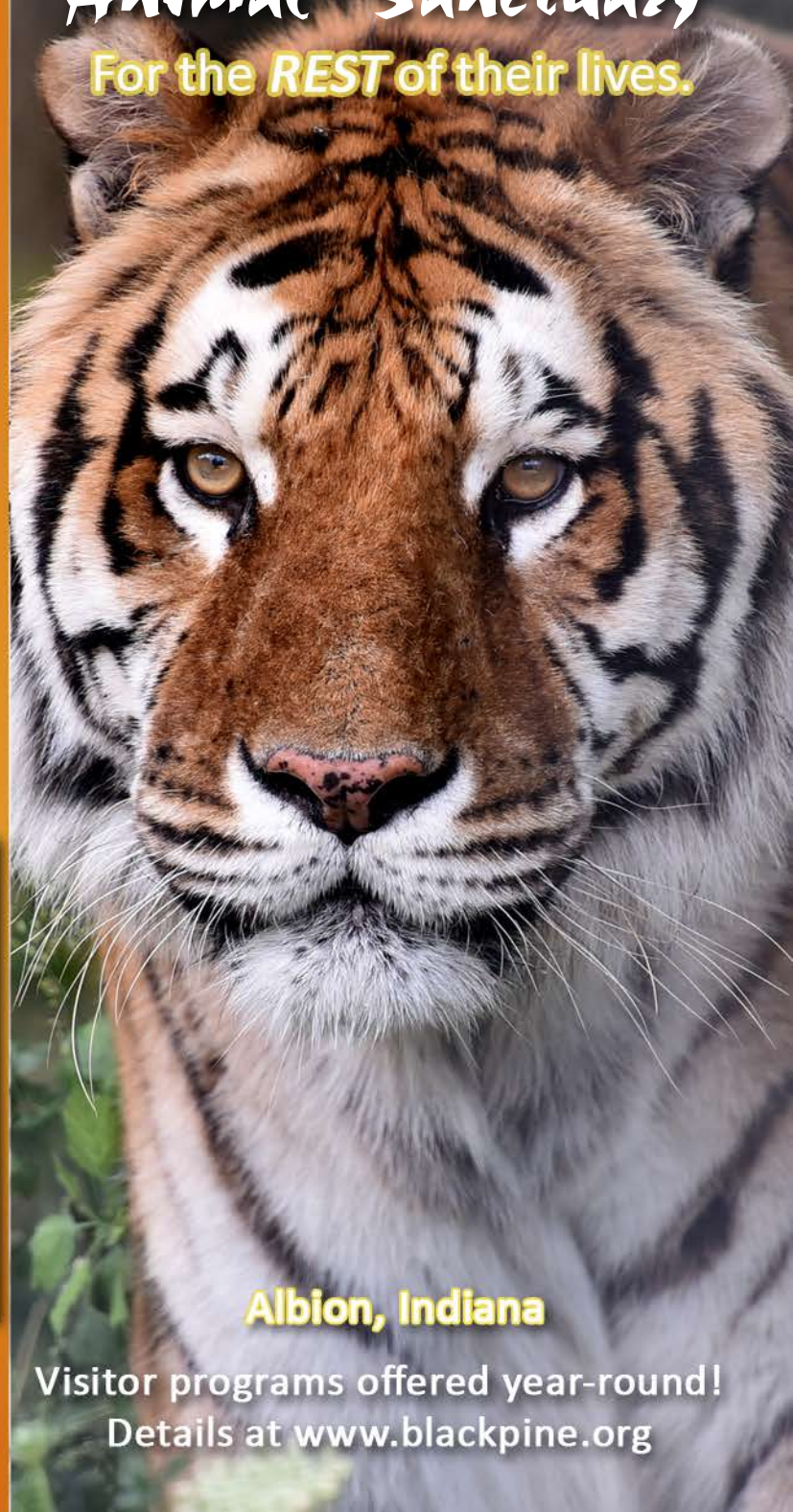

We exist to provide refuge to displaced, captive-raised exotic animals for the REST of their lives and to educate people about responsible animal care and conservation.

About us

The sanctuary is home to more than 55 species of animals including tigers, lions, bobcats, foxes, wolves, monkeys, lemurs, parrots, lizards, snakes, donkeys, pigs, emus, and more. Most residents were voluntarily surrendered. Others were ordered removed by legal authorities. We do not buy, sell, breed, trade, or seek out animals.

Enjoy just over 1/2 mile of walking paths that bring you up close to observe and learn about the animals and our mission. Picnic areas are available at no added charge. Parking and Wi-Fi are free!
